



Car or Motorbike




Our parking is located beneath the Passport Building.



Please share your **car information** (model, license plate) with your Microsoft host to benefit from a **direct access** (the barrier opens automatically).



Electric cars **charging stations** are available.



Car or Motorbike



1. On the Brussels ring, follow the A201 Zaventem Airport.

2. Stay on the main road A201 and keep left (over the viaduct).



3. After the viaduct, keep to the far right and follow the indication



4. Keep left and follow the indication



5. You arrive at a roundabout.


Follow the indication



6. Take the 2nd exit and follow the sign "Passport". Visitors to the Passport building are allowed to take this road.



7. Keep left and go straight ahead.



Car or Motorbike



8. At the roundabout, take the first exit.




9. Take the right-hand entrance. If you have shared your car information the barrier should open automatically. If not, you should can call the reception through the intercom.




10. The parking is the first located under the tunnel on the right hand-side after the barrier.
11. Microsoft spots will be recognizable thanks to signage.





Train



The train station is located **two floors down the arrival level** at Brussels Airport.

The train appears to be the **most advantageous** mean of transports to come to the airport.

There are **6 trains per hour** from Brussels city centre. The connection lasts between **15 and 20 minutes**.

An average price ticket to link Brussels airport to the European district is **about 8€**.




Bus

The bus station is located one floor down the arrivals at Brussels Airport. The access requires five minutes walk to reach Microsoft office.


There are 2 companies operating bus transports in Brussels region: STIB and De Lijn (Flemish).

- **STIB** owns two lines : 12 et 21. These lines are coming directly from Brussels city centre (European district) connection between Airport and OTAN (price ticket : 3,5€ from European district).
- **De Lijn**: not very advantageous but not very expensive / request a lot of time to come from Brussels because of the traffic.





Plane



Arriving by plane at the airport, you can access Microsoft office **very easily**.

The entrance of the building is on the **same level as the departures**.

The arrival floor is located one floor below this latter.
